REGISTRATION AND PAYMENT POLICIES FOR WOW 2021-2022

General Policies

This year a registration fee of \$50 per family per year will be accessed for ALL families, due upon registration. This fee is NON REFUNDABLE UPON SUBMITTING WOW REGISTRATION.

Class changes after registration must go through Stephanie Rappuhn at skrappuhn@gmail.com. A \$50 charge will be assessed for changes.

Part time OVA students MUST take at least (2) classes with WOW to register. The only exception is for part time students with dual enrollment courses; these students may take their one anchor course with WOW. Students in the WOW hybrid must take at least one elective with WOW. Offsite courses are limited to 2 per student total, per semester.

Part time students receive (5) funded elective classes each semester. Full-time virtual students NOT in the hybrid program receive (2) electives. Students in the WOW Hybrid program receive (2) electives and (4) core courses for a total of (6).

If a parent is not onsite or able to supervise, students MUST have a class each hour they are on the premises. Students MUST remain with their parents to stay onsite without a class. For grades 8-12, students may serve in a volunteer capacity. If a student would like to volunteer, they MUST fill out the volunteer application to be considered. They will be under the supervision of Naomi Powers and expected to follow her instructions for that hour. Volunteer selections will be available for the hours they are needed. Students choosing a volunteer position without applying will NOT be granted their choice. No new volunteers will be accepted second semester.

Students wishing to take more than their funded elective classes may choose to self-pay for additional classes. Any part time student taking more than 4 classes with WOW, or any full time student taking more than 1 WOW classes, may take advantage of a discounted rate of \$100 per additional class, plus any registration or supply fees, for additional classes. **However, this rate is nonrefundable after the add and drop date (9/14/21 and 2/8/22).** Families may also choose to pay the \$200 full self-pay rate; if we are forced to go virtual for more than 2 weeks, you will receive a prorated refund for the weeks we are not able to meet. With a refund, access will not be provided to any zoom classes self pay.

Self-pay costs (without OVA enrollment) are as follows:

Onsite elective classes: \$200 per class, plus any registration or supply fees

Offsite elective classes: \$250 per class, plus any registration fees

Core Classes: Math, Social Studies, Science, or ELA through our hybrid program \$350 per class, plus all curriculum

Invoices will be sent by June 30, 2021 (fall) and January 10, 2022 (winter), with payment or payment arrangements due August 20, 2021 (fall) and January 25, 2022 (winter). Students with unpaid balances without arrangements will have their registration held until arrangements or payment is made.

Hybrid Specific Policies

Please be mindful of the fact that after June 30th, any student dropping from the WOW Hybrid program will be charged a \$600 drop fee.

Hybrid families please be sure to take all available placement assessments prior to determining levels. Only ONE SET of curriculum will be provided by WOW per school year. If the level is later determined to be incorrect, the online and onsite courses will be altered, but the new curriculum purchase will be the family's responsibility. To avoid this, be sure to attend our NEW HYBRID student testing

Hybrid curriculum is the property of Melissa Redmond, Director of WOW, and any non-consumable items will be returned at the conclusion of the school year, date TBD. Loss or damage will result in reasonable fines or replacement fees.
