REGISTRATION AND PAYMENT POLICIES FOR WOW 2020-2021

- Part time OVA students MUST take at least (2) classes with WOW to register. Students in the WOW hybrid must take both electives with WOW. Offsite courses are limited to 2 per student, per semester.
- Part time students receive (4) funded elective classes each semester. Full-time virtual students not in the hybrid program receive (2) electives. Students in the WOW Hybrid program receive (2) electives and (4) core courses for a total of (6).
 - NOTE* As a full time student, it is necessary to enroll in 4 core and 2 electives. However, WOW Hybrid students, 1st-8th grade, may choose to "flex" social studies or science. In place of the WOW social studies or science course, students may complete a social studies or science course of their own at home, but must also complete the full online OVA course "core explorers". This course covers all state standards for that grade, and is meant to be used in conjunction with another curriculum. Students will then be offered another elective option in place of the "flex" core class. It is very important to remember that if a student chooses this option, they will then need to be picked up from WOW or have a parent onsite directly supervising the student, as they will not have a social studies or science course at that time; they will be expected to complete core explorers at home.
- If a parent is not onsite or able to supervise (for example, teaching or in a volunteer position), students MUST have a class each hour they are on the premises. For grades 7-12, students may serve in a volunteer capacity. If a student would like to volunteer in a particular course, they MUST have prior approval from the instructor, and will be expected to act as a classroom aide for the entire hour, all semester. Students wishing to be a hall monitor or front door helper must contact Stephanie Rappuhn and have prior approval; they will be under the supervision of Naomi Powers and expected to follow her instructions for that hour. These selections will be available on the registration form; please indicate which job is prefered in the Volunteer Notes Section.
- Students wishing to take more than their funded elective classes may choose to self-pay for additional classes. Any part time student taking more than 4 classes with WOWHG, or any full time student taking more than 2 classes, will be charged a rate of \$100 per additional class, plus any registration or supply fees, for additional onsite classes. This rate is nonrefundable after the add and drop date (9/17/20) and (2/11/20). If you chose the \$200 full self-pay rate, and a quarantine situation occurs again you will receive a prorated refund for the weeks we are not able to meet; you will not receive access to the zooms courses with a refund.
- Parents may also commit to a volunteer position to offset self pay course. A volunteer sign up doc will be released in July; for every 2 volunteer commitments (a semester in duration), one free onsite class will be awarded.

- Self-pay costs (without OVA enrollment) are as follows:
 - Onsite elective classes: \$200 per class, plus any registration or supply fees
 - Offsite elective classes: \$250 per class, plus any registration fees
 - Core Classes: Math, Social Studies, Science, or ELA through our hybrid program \$350 per class, plus all curriculum
- Invoices will be sent by August 1st, 2020 (fall) and January 1, 2021 (winter), with payment or payment arrangements due August 31, 2020 (fall) and January 25, 2021 (winter). Students with unpaid balances without prior arrangements will have their registration held until arrangements or payment is made.
- *Hybrid families* please be sure to take all available placement assessments prior to determining levels. **Only ONE SET of curriculum will be provided by WOW per school year.** If the level is later determined to be incorrect, the online and onsite courses will be altered, but the new curriculum purchase will be the family's responsibility.
- Hybrid curriculum is the property of Melissa Redmond, Director of WOW, and any non consumable items will be returned at the conclusion of the school year, date TBD. Loss or damage will result in reasonable fines or replacement fees.
- Hybrid enrollment is for the FULL YEAR. If, for any reason, your family decides to withdraw from the program or move to part time mid year (if available), there will be a cost of \$600 per student to cover curriculum costs.
