- Please check ALL the tabs along the bottom of the schedule Offsite, Fall Thursday, Winter Thursday, Fall Tuesday, Winter Tuesday
- Each WOW course name has a link that takes you directly to the course description for that course.
- This is a FULL YEAR registration! You will be asked to pick courses for both semesters. There will be a 1 WEEK change time in November to allow for changes in the classes; after that week, changes will be \$50 per change and based on availability in the class.
- Keep in mind, offsite courses are limited to 2 per student, per semester.
- Always have an alternative in mind, as classes do fill quickly. You may also ask to be placed on a waitlist, and if there is a spot that opens, you will be changed to your first choice for free, prior to the semester beginning.
- The self-pay discount is still available for \$100 per course if you have reached your limit of OVA funded courses. This rate is nonrefundable after the add and drop date. If you chose the \$200 full self-pay rate, and a quarantine situation occurs again you will receive a prorated refund for the weeks we are not able to meet; you will not receive access to the zooms for the course with a refund.
- If a parent is not onsite, students MUST have a class each hour they are on the premises. For grades 7-12, students may serve in a volunteer capacity. If a student would like to volunteer in a particular course, they MUST have prior approval from the instructor, who then must let me know. In the TBD courses, please contact me:) With this position, they are expected to be an aide, and must be willing to help each week for the entire hour- attendance will be taken.

Section 10-12:

- -High school courses are listed by time, but K-8 are listed by level. These times will be determined after registration based on numbers. You will only need to choose the appropriate level for these grades.
 - There are 2 days of math- instruction on Thursday, instruction and testing on Tuesday.
 - MS students (English 6,7,8) are highly recommended to choose 1 of the MS writing lab times on Thursday. The full benefit of instruction will not be there without this second day. Although I planned on offering a free ELA based elective for 1-5, there is just not space or availability to do so:/ I apologize!!
 - Prior to registration, for new students to hybrid, please check your appropriate reading levels for 1-3rd grade, and math for all levels. It is ideal for your child to be on the

correct level from the beginning!! **ONE SET OF CURRICULUM WILL BE PURCHASED BY WOW BASED ON PARENT INPUT!** If the level is incorrect, you will be placed in the correct course onsite, but will be required to purchase your own materials. If your child is more than 1 level up or down from their registered grade level, or struggles with reading or math, please reach out for further instruction.
